The **\$500 Scholarship** may be used for any purpose related to the recipient's degree program expenses. The applicant must currently be enrolled in an ALA-accredited Masters Degree program and have completed six (6) hours. The applicant must currently be an employee of a Mississippi library and must not have previously been awarded this scholarship from CMLC.
