PIANO **CHAMBER MUSIC CAMP**

Join us at Millsaps College for a week of learning the art of chamber music this summer!

The Summer Piano Chamber Music Camp is a weeklong camp for young pianists to promote and encourage the development of chamber music performance.

At the camp, rising 7-12 grade students work with Millsaps piano faculty in a supportive atmosphere of collaborative music-making.

Each day, campers participate in activities including:

- ensemble coaching
- classes
- rehearsals
- and faculty master classes and performances.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Student performers must:

- have at least two years of experience in private lessons
- Submit a completed application before May 28
- Submit a nonrefundable deposit of \$100, which will be applied to tuition.

Application and deposit are due before May 28.

Students must submit full tuition payment by June 17 to reserve their spot.

FEES

Tuition is \$350. If a student is using the Bach Festival Scholarship award, these payments will be sent directly to Millsaps College.

WITHDRAWAL FROM CAMP

Once registered, campers are arranged into small ensembles. As such, withdrawal from the camp will affect the ensemble to which the student has been assigned. Please notify Rachel Heard immediately if you cannot participate in the camp for any reason. **Refunds will be allowed until May 28.**

CAMP PROGRAMMING INCLUDES:

CHAMBER MUSIC COACHING SESSIONS

Before camp, each student will be placed in two ensembles, according to his/her level of performance and study, and receive their ensemble music. During camp, ensembles will work on material with faculty and have time to rehearse on their own and as a group.

MUSIC THEORY AND HISTORY AND SPECIAL TOPICS CLASSES

Each day, students spend two hours devoted to the study of essential music theory and history. These are introductory classes; no prior experience is necessary. Special Topics classes introduce students to other aspects of music making.

PERFORMANCE OPPORTUNITY

At the end of the week, student ensembles will present their work in the recital, on Friday, June 28 at 3:00 p.m. in the Millsaps Academic Complex Recital Hall. Parents, family and friends are invited to attend. There will also be a student solo recital at 12:30 p.m. on Thursday, June 27 where students may present one of their solo pieces in a recital for the other campers.

FACULTY RECITALS

During camp, students will observe the art of creating music in the chamber setting as members of the faculty hold their own recitals. These performances are open to the public and will be held in the Millsaps College Gertrude C. Ford Academic Complex Recital Hall at 12:30 p.m. each day.

DROP OFF AND PICK UP SCHEDULE

Student drop-off is from 8:30-9:00 a.m. Student pick-up is from 3:30-4:00 p.m.
